#### CANCELLATION POLICY

Our cancellation policy is two (2) weeks prior to camp. If you do not give at least two (2) weeks notice, then your deposit cheque will not be returned to you.

### DETAILS

The camp will begin Sunday, August 21st, and run through until camp closing on Saturday, August 27th.

Staff at our camp includes group counsellors/advisors, a camp nurse, and a lifeguard who will be in attendance at all times.
