Dear Mr. Baron

TEAM is in receipt of the letter from Don Rooney, Labour Relations Director of MTS Inc. dated April 8, 2013 requesting the appointment of a Conciliation Officer.

The Parties met over fourteen (14) days since February 4, 2013. However, monetary items have not been discussed other than TEAM stating it was not at the table to negotiate concessions. Neither Party has presented a detailed monetary package to the other. TEAM has requested disclosure of employee information which will impact the content of the detailed monetary package. To date MTS has not provided TEAM with all information requested. Three (3) days of bargaining were scheduled April 9-11. TEAM informed MTS it required one full day of preparation after receiving the requested employee information. MTS informed TEAM April 9 that the information would not be available in time to allow for the bargaining on those dates.

While TEAM is concerned MTS's application is premature, we look forward to working with the Conciliator to achieve a collective agreement.
